When a natural disaster strikes (earthquakes, typhoons), what would you do and where would you flee? This is the drill designed for non-Japanese residents to learn about how to respond to natural disasters here in Gunma.

When:

November 2 (Sat.) 13:00-16:15 hours (Registration starts at 12:30.)

Kiryu Shi Kita Taiikukan (North Gymnasium)

Program: The drill will be conducted in simple Japanese.

- Learn about natural disasters in Japan
- Learn about shelter (The place you evacuate if a disaster strikes.)
- Learn about emergency food (Something you eat at a shelter), and others

Participants: The drill is free (No fee is involved.)

- Gunma's foreign residents (Need to apply to participate.)
- Approx. 30 people (On a first-come, first-served basis)
- ☆ Participants will receive emergency food (Rice, bread, yokan, etc.)
